

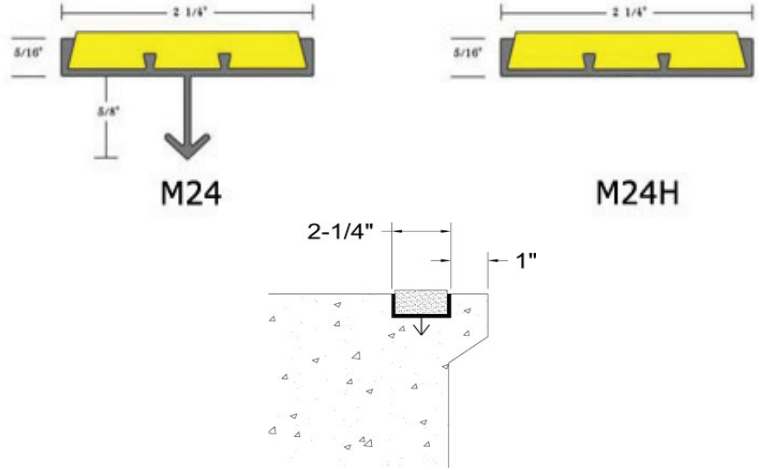

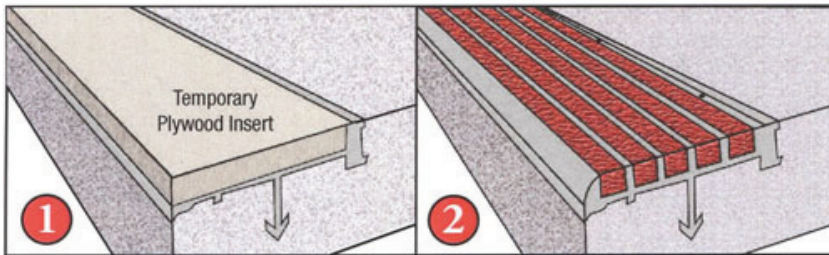
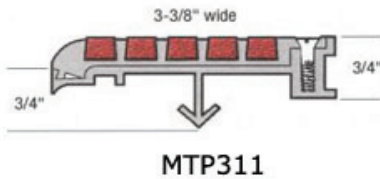
State of California Title 24

The state of California stripping code for the visually impaired calls for all stair treads to have an anti-slip strip of contrasting color 2 inches wide parallel to and not more than 1 inch from the front nose of each step.

Our Type M24 safety strip meets all the requirements of California Title 24. It is available with an extruded anchor for poured stairs and with holes for anchoring in wood or stone.

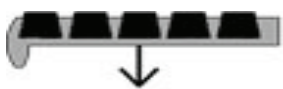


2 Part System - Replaceable



This system allows easy replacement of the safety nosing. Our M311 is made of 2 components consisting of the same high quality extruded aluminum and epoxy abrasive filler as our other extruded stair nosings. The sub channel is shipped with a pre-fabricated plywood board ready for installation in poured concrete stairs. Prior to final stages of construction, the plywood board is removed and the safety tread is fastened to the sub channel. The safety tread can be replaced with a new unit at any time after the initial installation.
